


Interested in Coding From Home!!!!!!

Home Health Coding Solutions is conducting a training course to prepare you for certification in the specialty of ICD 10 Home Health Coding.

Specialty certificates give an advantage in coding as most coders receive the CCA certification which thousands of people have obtained while the HCSD certification for Home Health has less than 700 people certified in the country. The Demand for Home Health Certified Coders far exceeds the amount of people currently qualified. Some companies have even outsourced to other countries.



Training will be done from 6pm-10pm over 12 weeks mainly on Thursday nights for attendees that are currently working full time during the day. The dates are February 2nd, 8th, 16th, 23rd March 2nd, 8th, 16th, 23rd, 30th April 12th, 20th, 27th May 4th, 10th. Training will be completed in Brigham City, Utah. The training will include weekly homework, practice test questions and a mock test with the HCSD time parameters given in class at the end of the training.

Cost of the training will be \$1,500.00 covering the entire course. A 50% deposit will "lock" your seat with the full amount of the training needing to be paid by January 15th, 2017.

Average wage of a certified coder is between \$22-\$25 a chart and after a few months you should be able to complete a chart in 45 minutes making your hourly rate around \$28-\$31 dollars an hour. Medical or nursing background is helpful but not required. I have had 3 nurses complete the course and pass the certification exam.
